Prior to the year 1645

The area of Common land in Torrington part of which is known as the Old Bowling Green must have been used for many years. Various decrees were issued by several Monarchs to the effect that, - 'all ball games should be prohibited and only Archery should be practiced'. This was to ensure that there was a ready supply of young able-bodied yeoman who could be called upon when the King waged war.

During Tudor times if any nobleman wanted to create a private bowling green, he was required to pay a levy of £100 to the King. A private green can still be seen at Dartington Hall in South Devon. King Charles the First was a keen bowler and gambled large sums of money on who could get closest to the jack. In fact, he was allowed to create a green at Carisbrooke Castle on the Isle of Wight during detention, prior to his execution.

Year 1645

The Castle Green was undoubtably in existence in 1645, as in a paper entitled "FAIRFAX IN THE WEST" published in Vol. XIII, page 169 of The Transactions of the Devonshire Association, the Author, Mr P. Q. Karkee, states that – "the Price's Guard were in the Castle Green" at the time of the engagement, at Great Torrington, between the Royalists and the Roundheads, on February 16th, 1646.

Year 1654

The Game of Bowls was being played at Torrington in 1654, as John Howe, who was at that time a Minister in the town (and later Cromwell's Chaplain at Whitehall), in a Sermon on "Thoughtfulness for the Future", alludes to the game as follows:- "and as men (in bodily exercise) when the bowl in out of their hands writhe and distort their bodies, as if they could govern its motion by those odd and ridiculous motions of theirs; so are we apt to distort our minds into uncouth shapes and postures, to as little purpose, more pernicious, and upon a true account not less ridiculous."

Year 1717

The Castle Green was laid out for recreation and the Summer house was built for THREE POUNDS SEVEN SHILLINGS AND FOUR PENCE (£3.7.4d) in the Castle Green. (Could be the present-day Gazebo)

Year 1741

Mr John Squires was paid 5 shillings for laying turf on the bowling green.

Year1837

This year Lord John Rolle of Stevenston granted a 21-year lease of the Castle Green to the Great Torrington Town Council – "specifically for the purpose of a bowling green" – at a rent of two shillings and six pence per quarter. (We have a copy of the lease in the club records and the club website.)

Year 1883

Bailey of the Castle – now known as Barley Grove – conveyed to the Town Council. It refers to the Bowling Green as already held by the Council. Assuming the lease of 1837 ran until 1862, sometime between 1862 and 1883 the Green was conveyed by either purchase or gift to the Town Council.

Year 1887

The oldest minutes of the Great Torrington Bowling Club which we possess begin to give a picture of life in the Town at the end of the last century.

It was recorded that the Club President was Mr G. Fisher, and the Secretary was Mr J.D. Copp. The club was invited to send a team to Plymouth for the Tercentenary celebrations of the Armada.

Year 1888

The club officials elected for this year were: President Mr G. Fisher, and Secretary Mr H. Bangham. The Club played against the Old Leeds Club to celebrate the 300th anniversary of the Armada. The Club wrote to the Leeds Club regarding the match at Plymouth insisting that they would only play with a 'non-biased jack'. Crown Green bowlers still play with a biased jack much larger than the one we play with today. The smaller jack appears to have been introduced around 1907. Lawn Tennis Jackets and white trousers were suggested for the match but subsequently costumes were provided by the Plymouth Celebration Committee.

Nine players were selected and these and together with the names of the markers can be seen engraved on the 1888 cup. (see photo below)



Year 1889

In May of that year the sets game was played – first to seven shots, proving that the present scoring system seen on televised World Indoor Championships is not a new format.

The silver cup was given to the President Mr G. Fisher for safekeeping and Mr I. Slee was asked to make a stand and box in which to keep the Cup. There is no record of payment to Mr Slee for making the same and it would appear that it is not done.

NOTE: in 1991 we have finally had a mahogany plinth made, which not sets off the silver cup in all of its splendour.

Year 1890

The club officials elected for this year were:

President Mr J. Adams, and Secretary Mr H. Bangham.

This year saw the club's first match with Barnstaple at Torrington and Torrington won by 66 points.

Year 1891

The greenkeeper was instructed to roll the green three times and cut it twice a week. He was paid £11 for 22 weeks work during the season.

There were 10 Honorary and 75 Members. The Annual Subscription was five shillings. (this was equivalent to a week's wage)

Year 1893

The club officials elected for this year were: President Mr J. Jackson, and Secretary Mr H. Blatchford.

Year 1894

The club officials elected for this year were: President Mr J. Jackson, and Secretary Mr H. Blatchford.

Torrington played the following matches for the Bowling Union Championship: On the 16th of May against Bideford at Bideford and scored 212 points against 215 points. On the 30th of May against Barnstaple at Torrington and scored 156 points against 80 points. On the 28th of June against Bideford at Torrington and scored 271 points against 149 points. On the 25th of July against Barnstaple at the Victoria Road ground in Barnstaple and scored 125 points against 114 points.

Torrington won the Bowling Union Championship and after all the matches were played it was agreed that all future matches for the championship shall be played on a neutral ground.

Year 1895

The club officials elected for this year were: President Mr J. Jackson, and Secretary Mr H. Blatchford.

Torrington played the following matches:

On the 13th of June against Ilfracombe at Torrington and scored 150 points against 69 points. On the 26th of June against Barnstaple at the Victoria Road ground in Barnstaple and scored 204 points against 229 points.

On the 10th of July against Bideford at Bideford and scored 220 points against 207 points. On the 1st of August against Ilfracombe at Ilfracombe and scored 132 points against 103 points. On the 8th of August against Bideford at Torrington and scored 251 points against 150 points.

Year 1896

The North Devon Bowling League was formed, and the first match was between Torrington and South Molton at Torrington. The teams play with 3 teams of 3 players each team and played 3 rounds of matches.

The final score was Torrington 165 points and South Molton 95 and both teams after the match retired to the Fishley's Commercial Hotel for tea.

Year 1908

A North Devon Division of the Devon County Bowling Association was proposed and accepted. During this year the Torrington Green was re-laid.

Year 1912

The club officials elected for this year were:

President Mr F.R. Boatfield, Secretary Mr F.W. Hodge, and Captain Mr C.R. Doe.

At the A.G.M. it was reported that the Club had lost, for the first time in the Club's History, a home game on the Castle Green. (perhaps the re-laying of the green had something to do with it).

Torrington won the Devon County Trophy.

In the first match on the 6th of June at Barnstaple they beat Ilfracombe by 32 points. In the second match on the 20th of June at Cowick they beat Barnstaple by 35 points. In the third match on the 17th of July at Tiverton they beat Exonia by 76 points. In the fourth match on the 5th of September at Heavitree they beat Tiverton by 36 points. Finally, on the 12th of September at Barnfield, they played Torquay, and the match was drawn, but after 5 extra ends Torrington won by 13 points.
